

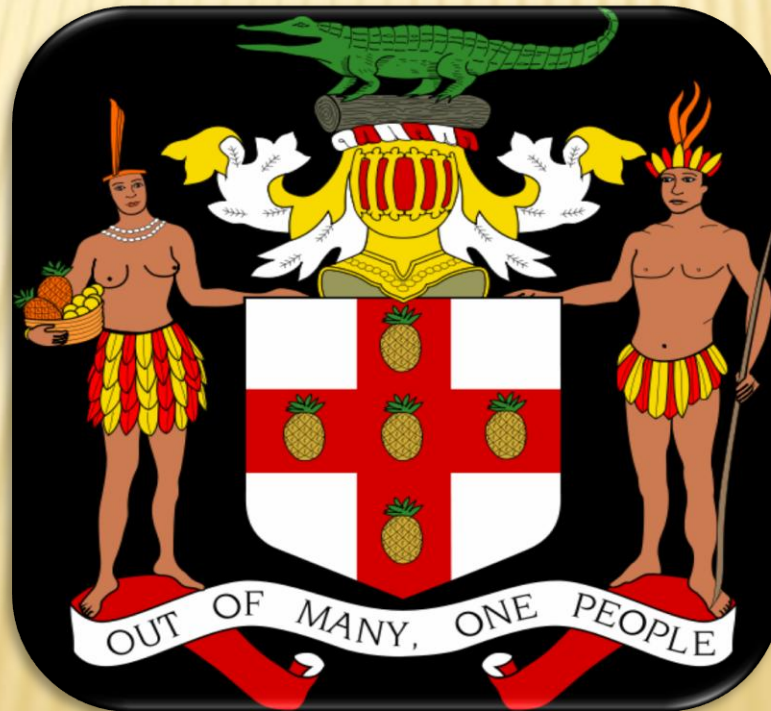

THE ISLAND OF JAMAICA

- ✘ Welcome to the island of Jamaica! The third largest Caribbean island, measuring 146 miles at its widest point. Primarily of volcanic origin, the lush island features a mountain ridge that peaks at Blue Mountain which is 7,402 feet high. Many white-sand beaches and clear seas ring the island.



- ✘ With an island of this size, there has to be some where for the hundreds of motorsport enthusiasts that call this island home to enjoy the past time that so many from around the world have come to love. RALLYING!!



THE HISTORY OF THE JAMAICA MILLENNIUM MOTORING CLUB

- ✘ The Jamaica Millennium Motoring Club, was originally known as the Jamaica Motoring Club.
- ✘ The JMC came to be in the mid 60's when the "Auto Owners Club", which had formed in 1957, merged forces with the "Forces Motoring Club". An organization originally from the British Military, stationed overseas. This club was closely linked with the British based Royal Automobile Club (RAC), who in turn were affiliated with the Federation Internationale de L'Automobile (FIA), the world's governing body for motor sport.





- ✘ The unified clubs renamed in the early 70's to the Jamaica Motoring Club (JMC), and incorporated in February 1970, to become the driving force behind motorsports in Jamaica. The JMC quickly moved to obtain recognition by the FIA, which enabled them to host International Rallies, attracting World Rally Championship (WRC) class drivers and machinery, with some events boasting as many as seventy (70) entries.
- ✘ Without the assistance of market orientated corporate sponsors, who have reaped the full benefits of both local and international recognition by the presence of local and international press and advertising and public relations support, the high levels of competition could never have been achieved.

- ✘ The JMC has over the last 3 decades organised or assisted in circuit racing at Vernamfield and Dover Raceway, in addition to this they have also organised numerous sprints, dexterities and not to mention rallies such as BOAC Speed Bird Rallies, Carreras Rallies, Red Stripe Rallies, Good Year Cross Country Rallies, Esso International Rallies and the PETCOM Invitational Rallies.



- ✘ During the mid 70's Jamaica suffered from various World crisis, which caused a decline in motorsport; however the Jamaica Motoring Club strove to move past this, hosting various small rallies and other smaller motorsport events. It wasn't till the mid 80's that motorsport regained its popularity, with a renewed effort by the JMC to stage larger, better organized events. The JMC to date has hosted several international events which have attracted a high calibre of overseas competitors from countries such as Barbados, Trinidad & Tobago, The United States of America, Britain, Sweden, Australia and Japan.

- ✘ It wasn't until 1996 that the JMC renewed its affiliation with the FIA. Now having been granted the position as the Governing Body for Motorsports in Jamaica, the JMC became once again actively involved in all areas of motorsport.
 - ✘ Effective March 2003 the club changed its name to the Jamaica Millennium Motoring Club.

WHAT IS RALLY JAMAICA?

- ✘ Rally Jamaica is a gravel event consisting of 3 days of rallying, 2 of which are very intense.
- ✘ Starting Friday night in the heart of Kingston. Drivers are given a chance to show their cars and mingle with their much loved fans before they are exposed to the rigors of the next two days.
- ✘ Saturday stages take drivers out to Moneague. To traverse stages such as the Bauxite Mines in Lydford. If not truly prepared drivers stand little chance of even making it through the day and after making it through that. They still have to remember that there is still Sunday to come.
- ✘ Drivers who have made it through Saturday, now have the Orange groves of the Tru Juice Plantation on Sunday. So this means look out for an out of place orange tree if not it could all be over before you even know it. But even after that there is still the highly anticipated finish. Usually kept under lock and key till the official press launch, spectators flock by the thousands to see those drivers, who have made it to the finish let their hair down and put on a show.

RALLY JAMAICA TROPHY

- ✘ Through out the last 19 years Rally Jamaica has not just seen drives from within the island, but also many regional and international drivers some also from the World Rally Circuit. However, the highly coveted trophy has never left the shores of Jamaica. Could 2011, Rally Jamaica's 20th Anniversary, be the year that the trophy departs for parts unknown?

- ✘ The above rates include third party insurance coverage and unlimited kilometres.
 - ✘ These rates are subject to 17.5% General Consumption Tax (GCT).
 - ✘ We have two options of Damage to Vehicle Waiver (DVW) that either limit or eliminate your liability in case of damage or loss to the rented vehicle. These two options are outlined below:
 - + Option 1
 - ✘ At a daily rate of between US\$8.00 and US\$15.00 your liability would be reduced from the full cost to a limited amount of US\$750.00 - US\$1200.00 in case of damage or loss to the rented vehicle.
 - + Option 2
 - ✘ To eliminate any liability in case of damage or loss to the rented vehicle the cost would be between US\$20.00 - US\$30.00 per day. A refundable security deposit of US\$250.00 or US\$450.00 would be required.

× Petrol

- + The vehicle is provided with a full tank of petrol which any portion used will be charged for.

× General Terms and Conditions

- + Drivers must be between the ages of 23 and 75 years of age.
- + Driver's Licence must be at least one year old.
- + One additional driver allowed free of charge, any other drivers cost US\$3.00 per day per driver.
- + All drivers must be named on the rental agreement or the insurance becomes null and void.
